PERSONAL/PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT GRANT (P/PDG)
FOR PART-TIME GRADUATE STUDENTS

To make graduate education more accessible to working students, TCU offers a limited number of “Personal/Professional Development Grants” for part-time graduate students enrolled in credit courses. These grants are available to students with higher income brackets than are usually considered for financial assistance.

AMOUNTS OF GRANTS

The P/PDG provides 1/4 tuition credit for up to six hours each semester. A total of six hours is allowed for all summer sessions combined.

INCOME LIMITATIONS

In order to be eligible, the adjusted gross income may not exceed:

- \$64,055* for independent, single students without dependents
- \$79,496* for married students or single students with dependents

*Note: Income ceilings and amounts of P/PDG are subject to change.

QUALIFICATIONS

Applicants must be:

- year-round part-time students (**enrolled for 8 hours or less**)
- accepted to the University before the P/PDG application may be considered
- U.S. citizens or permanent residents of the U.S.
- at least 22 years of age by the final day of late registration
- in good academic and financial standing at all colleges and universities attended

HOW AND WHEN TO APPLY

Awards are not retroactive. Applications are accepted by mail or in person (Sadler Hall 208 between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. Monday through Friday.) In order to verify eligibility, TCU reserves the right to review an applicant’s tax form and to contact an applicant’s place of employment regarding employee tuition grants or reimbursements.

STIPULATIONS

This grant is not available to individuals who are receiving other TCU administered aid. College of Education and Brite Divinity students are not eligible for this grant due to aid offered through their specific programs. The Master of Liberal Arts program is not eligible for this grant. Funds are limited and are awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.
