Academic Scholarship Agreement

- Your scholarship is renewable for eight semesters* or a total of 120 credit hours of undergraduate study, whichever comes first. Students in a major that require 124 or more credit hours (as defined in the Undergraduate Satisfactory Academic Progress Policy) may request an additional semester of funding.
- Academic scholarships, except for the Chancellor's Scholarship, are not intended to fund a specific percentage of tuition and do not increase in value if tuition is increased.
- The maximum duration of TCU-funded scholarships for transfer students is eight semesters, or up to bachelor degree completion, whichever comes first. *The maximum duration of Transfer Chancellor's Scholarship is up to six semesters.
- The scholarship will be split evenly between fall and spring terms, and pertain to undergraduate programs only.
- Scholarship funding is not available for summer study.
- You must enroll each semester as a full-time (minimum of 12 semester hours) student.
- To renew your scholarship, you must complete a minimum of 24 semester hours of letter grade TCU course work each academic year. Grades of "A," "B," "C," "D," and "P" count toward renewal. Grades of "F," "W," "Q," "NC," and "I" do not. For spring transfer students, 12 semester hours must be completed in the first spring term.
- Summer study does not count toward scholarship renewal.
- Advanced Placement (AP), CLEP, and SATII hours do not count toward scholarship renewal.
- A 3.00 TCU cumulative grade point average (GPA) is required at the end of the spring semester for first year undergraduate students. A 3.25 TCU cumulative GPA is required at the end of each spring semester for returning and transfer students.
- Students who do not meet renewal requirements will forfeit their scholarship. All students have the right to appeal the loss of their scholarship. Appeals are reviewed by the Scholarship Advisory Committee in June and July. See website for dates to be published.
